I. Security Measures

- Continued fear of terrorist threats in Iraq and Korea in case there is additional dispatch of troops with passing of the bill for the dipatch of Korean forces to Iraq
 - Troops, military facilities, foreign embassies, and legations abroad as well as main domestic facilities, and international conference participated by the main, international dignitaries are potential terror targets.
- May is high-demand season for travel in Jeju Island which may cause airport congestion and problems security checks

II. Management System for Security Measures

- Fomation of a security team (four persons) within KOAM for supervision of security duties
- Set up and management of a Field Security Control Room at the venues and hotels during Annual Meeting period
- Set up of an Entry/Exit Control Team at Incheon, Kimpo, and Jeju Airports
- Management of a Drink and Food Safety Control Team under Jeju local government
- Formation and management of a personal protection unit under Jeju Police Station

II. Management System for Security Measures

1. Exit/Entry Control Measures

Management of an Entry/Exit, Control Team, which consists of related organizations under the National Intelligence Service.

- Management from 8th May whenever necessary
- Take charge of entry and exit affairs of the participants
 - Reduce entry and customs procedures for participants by setting up an exclusive inspection counter
 - Prohibition of prohibited goods

2. Security Measures at ICC Jeju

- Set up a joint Field Safety Control Room for related organizations within ICC
 - Separately manage an individual field CP per security organization, including police and fire stations
 - Manage a system of 24-hours in two shifts during the Annual Meeting
- Station police units from 12th May and carry out Entry/Exit Control of non-official civilians; perform security checks
 - Perform security checks two hours prior to the start of main events, such as the Opening Ceremony
- Control entry of non-official civilians during the Annual Meeting
 - Main facilities including offices of ADB Secretariat and KOAM
- Perform security fire, electricity, and gas checks (perform once each day during the Annual Meeting)

3. Security Measures at the Hotels

- Set up a joint “Field Safety Control Room” with relevant organizations at Lotte Hotel
 - Manage a field CP, such as police and fire stations at Lotte and Silla hotel
 - Manage a system of 24-hour in two shifts during the Annual Meeting
- Record long-term hotel users in designated hotels before the Annual Meeting
- Allocate security staffs in the floor that main dignitaries stayed including the ADB President
- Strengthen terror and security awareness education targeted at the hotel staff during the Annual Meeting
- Perform checks on security fire, electricity, and gas (to be performed once each day during the Annual Meeting)

4. Measures for Personal Protection of Main Dignitaries

- Organize and manage a personal protection unit under the Jeju Police Station
 - Station bodyguards and provide an escort for the ADB President, Chairman, Presidents of other international organizations, and Korea-Japan delegation
 - Strengthen security awareness education for the protocol staff boarding the shuttle bus and rapidly for the participants
 - Additional stationing of transportation police officers during the movement of the main dignitaries
- Personal protection unit will be at the police CP and respond quickly.

5. Security Measures for Fire Station

- Prevention of accidents, such as fire, by conducting a joint security inspection in venues and hotels where participants are staying at Jeju government (Fire Station headquarters)
 - To be conducted twice a month prior to the events; To be conducted each day during the Annual Meeting schedule
- Strengthening of fire inspection of ICC and hotels during the Annual Meeting
 - Increase inspection from Local Fire Station (Three times a day)
- Strengthening of fire prevention awareness education and training in ICC and hotels during the Annual Meeting
- Providing emergency aides and ambulances in ICC and hotels during the Annual Meeting

6. Security measures for food and beverages

- Manage a “Food and beverage control team” under the Jeju government
 - Food safety specialists to reside in three hotels (Lotte, Shilla, and Hyatt)
 - Strengthen checks every time by local governments in other hotels
- Perform special checks for food and beverage provided at the Reception and venues for the Luncheon and Dinner
- Educate hotel staffs, staffs related to food and beverages, and function room staffs

7. Military Measure

- Strengthen maritime defense for preparation against illegal entry and camouflaged intruders during the Annual Meeting
- Preparations against biological and poisonous gas terror
 - Manage a “Protection against Poison” team and stay alert at all times
 - Station a gas detection assistant (One person) in the Meeting venue and detection equipment
- Preparation against car and main building terror
 - Manage a bomb removal team (EOD) and trained police dogs

8. Measures for the Prevention of Terror

- The National Intelligence Agency will organize “Team Against Terror” and “Cyber Terror Center” with related organizations and form an information cooperative system
 - Exchange information and prevent international terror groups and organizations from entry
 - Request preventive measures against cyber terror for the ADB Annual Meeting computer network
- Request terror preventive measures against hijacking of airplanes and vehicles transporting main dignitaries (Airport Entry/Exit Measure Team)
- Station special terror forces near the venues and hotels where participants are staying, and keep alert at all

9. Performance of Checks

- The National Intelligence Agency will form a security check team to prevent terror in the facilities.
 - The National Intelligence Agency, the Ministry of Government Administration and Home Affairs, Special Police Forces, Korea Electric Power Corporation, Korea Electrical Safety Corporation, Korea Gas Safety Corporation will consist of eight persons and will form a joint inspection team as well as check field conditions

** To be conducted twice prior to the ADB Annual Meeting*

- Local police, fire station, and other safety-related organization to perform checks for each part twice a month before the Meeting, and each day during the Meeting

10. Measures for Safety of Registration

ID cards of the host country need to be produced by special paper in order to prevent fabrication and forgery of ID cards and the number of issues to be limited by part.

ID cards can be reissued only once and the temporary ID cards are only valid for a day.

During the working period of the registration and the distribution center from 9th-17th May, security staff will be stationed. A person-in-charge at nighttime will be chosen and security measures will be carried out.

- Registration cards and temporary ID cards will be stored in dual file cabinets.
- Checking the numbers of registration cards to be performed at the end of the working hours and security checks to be performed.
